Questions and Answers

- Why are you seeking investors?
 - In order to expand our animal operations it normally takes years of retaining replacement breeding stock. We have been expanding slowly for almost 10 years and have never been able to fill all the demand that exists. With your help we will be able to purchase breeding stock from other local farmers. This will allow us to expand much faster than we can by ourselves, helping them and us to fulfill demand. This will allow us to reach more families in need of quality pasture based Non-GMO foods more quickly.
- What will the money be used for?
 - We will be using the capital for 3 primary purposes.
 - Purchase of more breeding stock (pork, beef, and lamb) to expand operations.
 - Infrastructure necessary to house and care for the increased head count.
 - Operating expenses for the expanded farm until the new momma's begin providing saleable offspring.
- How do we get a return on our investment?
 - By investing in our farm through our 3-year meat CSA; CSA stands for Community Supported Agriculture and it is the way that many farms and families pre-purchase food at the beginning of the season and have it delivered whenever it becomes available. In this instance your meat will be delivered at one time each year and over the course of the 3 year CSA term you will receive a 30% savings over our yearly price and over a 50% savings off the Average US consumer price (based on 2018 data from the US Bureau of Labor and Statistics).
- Why do we need to pre-purchase?
 - Pre-purchasing CSA shares allows the farmers the capital to purchase stock and seeds, pay employees, and handle expenses until their products begin coming available. Remember vegetables take time to grow and ripen; animals take MUCH longer than that; but before the harvest comes; farmers have costs for fuel, workers to pull weeds from the garden, hay to make, feed to buy, minerals to administer, etc. Your CSA share helps us 'get over the hurdle' financially.
- Can I buy a CSA share for someone else?
 - Absolutely! Think of wedding gifts, new additions to the family, graduation, heading off to college or just getting a new apartment. In all of these times in our lives many of us struggled with finances, good food was hard to afford. How important would it be for your children, grandchildren, friends, or church community members to receive a gift that will give to them for years to come?

- Are the CSA shares transferable?
 - Absolutely! If you are moving away or simply aren't using the share any longer for whatever reason, the balance of the share can be passed to someone else. Just send us a letter for verification with the new recipients contact information and we'll handle the rest. Please remember that the butcher needs to be local to our farm...we cannot deliver animals across state lines for processing.
- Can we split a share with someone else?
 - Yes you may; but not from the farm. If you want to divide the cost and split a share with someone else, you will need to handle that individually. The CSA gets a little overwhelming when we have extra people we are trying to contact, especially when the butcher is calling us as well 😊
- Does the upfront cost of the CSA share cover everything, every year?
 - Unfortunately no. You will still need to pay for the processing of the animals. We will handle scheduling and delivery of the animal to the butcher at no charge but due to the wide variety of cuts, smoking, sausages, etc. it can become quite expensive to handle all the dollars for all the possible specialties. You will have the ability to speak directly with the butcher to tell them how you want your animals processed so that there aren't any mistakes and you are happy with your meats. The return on your investment is based solely on the cost of the hanging weights of the animals each and every year.
- I do not eat pork; can I buy a share without it?
 - YES, we have different CSA packages available so you can get the meats you enjoy!
- Are Chickens or Turkeys available in the CSA?
 - Yes, we will have chicken and turkey on all the CSA share options. In addition you can pre-order more if you need them on a year-by-year basis.
