Potato Leek Soup

INGREDIENTS

3 large leeks (about 3 cups after chopping)
2 Tbsp butter
4 cups chicken broth (or vegetable broth for vegetarian option)
2 lbs potatoes (Yukon gold or Russet), peeled, diced into 1/2 inch pieces
1 teaspoon sea salt, less or more to taste
Pinch of dried marjoram
1 or 2 sprigs of fresh thyme, or 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme
1 bay leaf
1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley
Sprinkle of Tabasco sauce or other red chili sauce
White or black pepper to taste
